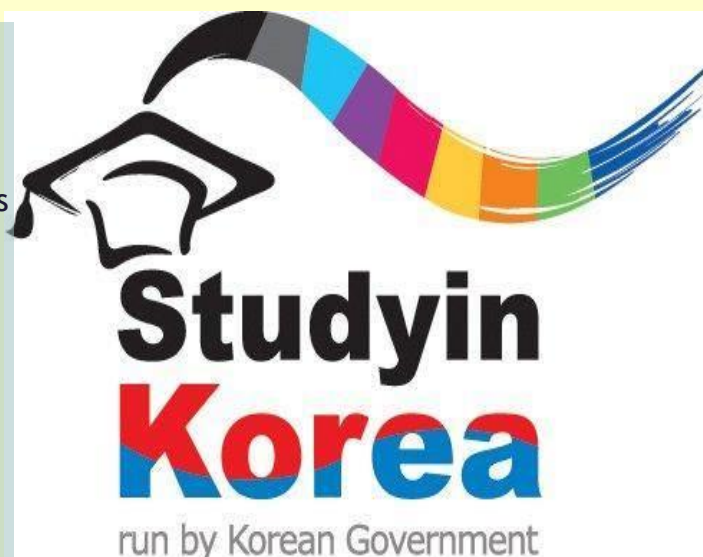
INU welcomes 19 International Students to the Global Korea Scholarship (GKS) program run by Korean government
