Before You Begin

Choose a program of study.

INU has 64 undergraduate degree programs (see page 11-12 for a list) that can help you achieve your career goals and knowing what they are will give you more options when you apply and some programs have special requirements.

Make sure you are eligible to apply.

Before you apply, make sure you thoroughly understand and meet the minimum admission requirements as summarized below.

- 1. Education:** High School Graduate or graduate-to-be.
 - 2. Nationality:** To be regarded as an international student, you and your parents must be non-Korean nationals. Your parents may not have dual citizenship in Korea and another country with the exception of Taiwanese nationals. A student whose parents are Korean and Taiwanese are considered international students.
 - 3. Language Proficiency:** You must decide if you are entering the School of Northeast Asia Studies (SONAS) that offers English-language only instruction or one of the other majors that are primarily delivered in Korean-language. Next, demonstrate the respective language proficiency for each by submitting the results of your language test.

For transfer students.

Transfer students must have completed a minimum of one academic year at a 4-year university (at least 2 regular semesters excluding summer/winter programs) or Graduated from 2 or 3 year college. Students from non-Korean universities are required to complete at least one-quarter of the credits needed for graduation (submitted transcripts must be issued prior to 6 months the application). First-year or second-year class status will be determined based on the number of credits completed. Special circumstances may be considered for credits from junior/ community or vocational college.



Checklist

Gather the following required documents before you start.

Forms

Application, Letter of Consent, Scholarship and Academic Qualifications forms (copies of these forms start on page 5).

Identification

Copy of your passport and copies of your parents' or guardians' passport or identification card/drivers license. When completing the application forms, please write your name as shown in your passport.

Birth / Family Relation Certificate

Translated and notarized copy (in Korean or English) of the certificates issued by your home country/state which is equivalent to a birth certificate or other documents which prove applicant's family relationship. In the case where parents/guardians are divorced or deceased, submit a notarized copy of the official proof documentation.

Transcripts and High School Diploma

Apostille authenticated or consulate notarized diploma and official school grades records. For Chinese graduates, submit credentials report from www.cdgdc.edu.cn. For transfer students, Diploma and transcripts from university attended.

Language Test Scores

For the School of Northeast Asian Studies (SONAS) the minimum English-language proficiency requirement is TOEFL-iBT 75, TOEIC-750 or IELTS-5.5. Alternatively, the SONAS Korean language proficiency requirement is at least TOPIK Level 4. SONAS transfer student applicants are selected based on English Proficiency only. For all other majors Certificate of Korean Proficiency including TOPIK Level 3, INUKLI Level 4 or INU Korean Proficiency Test Level 3 or higher is required with the exception of the Department of Korean Language and Literature, which requires TOPIK Level 4 or higher.

Record of Bank Balance

A certificate of a bank balance of more than \$20,000USD or equivalent in the name of the financial sponsor (a parent) or the applicant that is dated within 1 month prior to the application.

Income Verification

If applying for a needs-based scholarship, translated and notarized copy (in Korean or English) of parents', applicant's and spouse's proof of employment and certificates of income or filed tax forms for the most recent year.

Photos

Two color photos (3cm x 4cm)...attach one to the Application Form and enclose the other.

Immigration Documents

For applicants who live in Korea, provide copies of: 1) Immigration Certificate, 2) Alien Registration Card (front and back) and 3) Certificate of Entry and Departure record.

Apply online and after you apply send hard copies of your application forms and required documents (see checklist) to the INU Admissions Team afterward. Normally, you would pay the application fee, but this year it is waived for all international students. Check your admissions status online and promptly respond to any email requests you may receive from the INU Admissions Team.

What is Apostle and Korean Consulate Legalization?

Apostle certificates or Korean consulate legalization are needed to authenticate original documents including school transcripts and graduation diplomas by a designated authority in the country where the document was issued. Copies of these documents should be translated into Korean or English if not written in Korean, English or Chinese and notarized.

Paying your application fee (waived for Fall, 2018)

The application fee of ~~KRW50,000~~ is non-refundable and must be paid by the application deadline using the account information provided below. Attach a receipt of your payment to your application. If the payment is not made under the applicant's name, please notify the Admissions Office of the sender's name. Overseas remittance and currency exchange fees will be charged to the payee.

Finance Your Tuition

Scholarships

INU offers generous needs-based scholarships for almost all international students to help meet the cost of their education. Needs-based financial aid is designed to support international students in affording a quality higher education at INU. On average, 80% of international students receive scholarships that cover 50% to 100% of their tuition.

Scholarship decisions are made after a student is enrolled at INU. Scholarship decisions consider financial need or academic merit. Annual availability of scholarship funds, number of applicants and the timing of your application for admission are other key determinants.

After You Apply

Attend the interview.

International students will be contacted individually if necessary to schedule a time for an interview via video conference (e.g. Skype).

Admissions decisions will be posted on the INU Admissions Team website (<http://www.inu.ac.kr>). International students will also receive notification via email.

Get a scholarship.

After you pay tuition, you can get the Student ID for registering for courses using the INU Portal during the scheduled access periods.
