1. Duration of Coursework

- Combined B.A.&M.S.(1.5 years)
- Ph.D.(2 years)
- M.S.(2 years)
- Combined M.S.&Ph.D.(4 years)

2. Maximum Period of Study(Attending school) : 10 years from the date of admission

3. Course Credits for each semester

- Major: 9 credits recommended(maximum 12 credits)
- Prerequisite: Maximum 6 credits

4. Credit Requirements for Completion

- Combined B.A.&M.S.: Minimum 24 credits
- Ph.D.: Minimum 36 credits
- M.S.: Minimum 24 credits
- Combined M.S.&Ph.D.: Minimum 60 credits

5. Valid GPA : Minimum 70 points(C)

※ Valid CGPA for completion: CGPA of B or higher

6. Registration Type

- ① Regular Registration : Combined B.A.&M.S.(3 semesters), M.S.(4 semesters),
Ph.D.(4 semesters), Combined M.S.&Ph.D.(8 semesters)
- ② Research Registration : Registration for submitting thesis after completion of study
(Once 15% payment of tuition for the semester)
- ③ Credit Registration : Registration for a student who lacks credits after regular registration
 - 1 credit ~ 3 credits : ½ Payment of tuition
 - More than 4 credits : Full payment of tuition

7. Leave of Absence

In the case of taking a leave of absence due to illness or other unavoidable reasons, application must be done within a designated period.

※ The term of absence cannot exceed two semesters continuously

※ Also, it cannot exceed five semesters in total

① General Leave of Absence

If more than 1/3 of the number of school days cannot be taken due to unavoidable reasons after registration, a student should submit an application for a leave of absence within 30 days at the beginning of the semester.

② Military Leave of Absence

A student who wants to take a military leave of absence should submit an application for the leave of absence and a notice of enlistment 10 days before the date of enlistment.

③ Pregnancy/Childbirth/Childcare Leave of Absence

A student who wants to take a pregnancy/childbirth/childcare leave of absence should submit an application for the leave of absence 10 days before the scheduled date.

- Should attend at least 2/3 of the class days every semester to earn credits

- ② Examination subject: English, German, French, Japanese or Chinese
 - * Foreign students can choose Korean but cannot choose own mother tongue language
- ③ Passing Score
 - M.S. and combined B.A.&M.S.: Higher than 60 points
 - Ph.D. and combined M.S.&Ph.D.: Higher than 70 points
- ④ Re-test: Those who fail, can take the test again regardless of the number of times

- Application period: Tue 3/March/2026 09:00 ~ Thu 5/March/2026 16:00
- Face-to-Face test: March 16, 2026 (Tue)
- Foreign Language Test Exemption
 - Completion of Online lecture designated by Graduate School or Certified Language Test Result within 2 years
 - Exemption Submission period: Mon 1/Sep/2025 09:00 ~ Tue 16/Sep/2025 16:00
 - Submission: Apply through the online portal system and attach supporting documents

2. Comprehensive Test

① Qualification for application

- A student who has passed the foreign language test and acquired GPA of B or higher in 18 credits for [combined B.A.&M.S. and M.S.](#), 27 credits for [Ph.D.](#) and 51 credits for [combined M.S.&Ph.D.](#)

② Examination subject: select 2 subjects among all complete courses

③ Passing grade: Higher than 70 points (You can retake a test for subjects failed)

④ Test schedule: March ~ April, September ~ October



5. Thesis Submission and Examination

1. Assignment of thesis advisor
 - Application for assignment of advisor at the first semester regardless of degree program
2. Submission of research proposal
 - Combined B.A.&M.S.: 2nd semester
 - M.S. and Ph.D.: 3rd semester
 - Combined M.S.&Ph.D.: 7th semester
 - * You must submit a presentation opinion during the semester of submitting the research proposal
 - * Failure to submit the research plan and presentation opinion form will result in the inability to submit the thesis in the following semester
3. Passing grade of thesis preliminary examination and examination
 - M.S. and Combined B.A.&M.S. : Pass if 2 or more of 3 examiners give more than 80 points
 - Ph.D. and Combined M.S.&Ph.D.: Pass if 4 or more of 5 examiners give more than 80 points
 - * It is possible to issue a certificate of the expectant degree after passing the thesis examination

- Current student designated as the lead (first or corresponding) author in the article
- Must state affiliation as Incheon National University (current address is not accepted)
- JCR criteria are calculated by JIF RANK based on the recent JCR YEAR's Journal Impact Factor
- If there are several fields to which the journal belongs, the highest percentage is applied
